### **Academic Programs**

#### **YEAR 7-8**

#### Year 7 & 8 Subjects – Building a Strong Foundation

In Years 7 and 8, students experience a broad and balanced curriculum that supports academic growth, personal development, and the discovery of their God-given talents. Students engage in:

- Faith and Personal Growth Subjects: Homeroom, Christian Living, Equip
- Core Academic Subjects: English, Humanities, Mathematics, Science
- Specialist Subjects: Health & Physical Education, French, Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Food Technology, STEAM.

#### YEAR 9-10

#### Year 9 & 10 Subjects – Expanding Choice. Deepening Learning.

In Years 9 and 10, students continue to build strong academic foundations while beginning to personalise their learning journey. Students engage in a broad core curriculum and explore areas of interest through a wide range of semester-based electives. Students engage in

- Faith and Personal Growth Subjects: Homeroom, Christian Living, Equip
- Core Academic Subjects:
  - English (Year 10 options: Justice, Rights and Power, Survival Tales, Sports Writing, Australian Literature)
  - Humanities (Year 10 options: Geography, World at War, Nazi
  - Germany, Stalinist Russia, Ancient Greece)
  - Mathematics (Streamed: Standard or Core)
  - Science.
- Health and Physical Education
- Electives.
